

Final Exam Preparation Guide

Group Communication

- The final exam will take three hours and is administered in two parts. Part A contains a 100-item multiple choice/true false exam that is taken individually (75 minutes). Part B contains three essay items that is taken with your classroom group (requiring a group response) and includes 50 possible points. Thus, there are 150 possible points on the final exam.
- Materials for both part A and B will be drawn from the entire course text and the class slides/lectures over the entire term.
- To prepare for the exam, in addition to reviewing the chapters, I suggest that you also review the reading quizzes for the first 9 chapters (chapters 10, 11, & 12 were not quizzed).
- I will provide the opscan sheets and exam materials for part A as well as the materials for part B.
- I suggest that you spend time reviewing the vocabulary of group communication (highlighted terms that appear in the glossary of the text.)
- Any extra credit earned in the final discussion round will be applied to the final exam.
