What is " Communication Competence"?

- * Competence (knowledge) is not the same as Performance (execution)
- * Trait (enduring) versus state (situational)
- * Two dimensions:
 - * Effectiveness dimension (goal attainment)
 - * Appropriateness dimension (communicative "fit")
- * Competence = Effectiveness (knowledge) + Appropriateness (knowledge in performance)

There Are Many Domains of Communication Competence

Codes and Media:

- Nonverbal (emblems, illustrators, affect displays, haptics, kinesics, proxemics, chronemics, vocalics)
- Visual (aesthetic, technical—color, contrast, intensity; movements, pacing, etc.)
- * Language (Phonetic, semantic, syntactic, pragmatic)
- Conversation (style, turn-taking, topic management, initiation/leave-taking)
- * Written (vocabulary, grammar, mechanics, documenting, genre, etc.)

There Are Many Domains of Communication Competence

Contextual:

- Relational (coordinated management of meaning, uncertainty reduction, relational support and control, synchrony, conflict management, humor, sexual relating, etc.)
- Mediated-Relational [IM, texting, persona management, social presence, media efficacy (refers to the belief in one's ability to use an interpersonal medium proficiently to perform ordinary social interactions), etc.]
- Group (leading, information management, decision making, problemsolving, conflict management, etc.)
- Mediated-Group [E-platform management (Skype, go-to-meeting, etc.), chat-room management, slides, visuals, etc.)
- Organizational (Organizational culture, organizing, information management, networks, power, and so on)
- Mediated-Organizational (Websites—design, traffic management, etc.), information portals, wiki's, blogs, hyper links, etc.)
- * Media (Media consumption literacy, digital media production skills, etc.)
