General Review

 - A. Study the various *Pēnsa B* from *Capitula XXV-XXVIII*.
 - B. You remain responsible for vocabulary from previous chapters—of course!
- II. Grammar.
 - A. Study the various *Pēnsa A* from *Capitula XXV-XXVIII*.
 - B. Know the principle parts from all the verbs we have seen so far.
 - C. Know how to conjugate in any of the tenses and moods we have seen so far.
 - D. Know the various uses the subjunctive.
 - E. Know how to GNC any of the nouns we have seen so far.

Format

The written is designed to take 90 minutes and will consist of extracts from the *lēctiōnēs* from *Capitula XXV-XXVIII*. During this exam you will be required to:

- 1. translate from Latin into English.
- 2. parse any of the verb forms, including irregular verbs, that you have seen in Latin up until this point (i.e. indicate person, number, voice, tense, mood).
- 3. identify why the subjunctive is being used.

If you do not know a word, you may ask (up to 6 times) for its dictionary forms and definition.

The best thing you can do to study for this exam is to re-read *Capitula XXV-XXVIII*. and review verbal forms!
